RANGE PROTOCOL

All persons present on the Range need to "sign" a release. All persons under the age of 18 must have a second responsible person sign along with them (this person also is required to sign an individual form)

All firearms entering the Range should be cased and unloaded

Uncasing should only happen at the benches on the rifle range and at the table at the pistol range

Firearms on the rifle range are only to be loaded when firing and from the bench (unattended firearms and during stand downs - actions should be open and firearms unloaded)

Firearms at the pistol range should only be loaded at the line of fire (magazines may be loaded at the table)

All firearms should be pointed at the target when locked

When a malfunction happens keep the firearm pointed at the target, ask for help.

The Range Officer has the last and only say on acceptable targets, number of rounds being fired in succession, full auto usage and reserves the right to not allow firearms that appear to be unsafe or excessive from use at the range.

The Range officer has the right to remove anyone from the range with/without cause.

"Cease Fire" Range Officer can call at any time, anyone on the firing range may also call for a "Cease Fire".

At time of called "CEASE FIRE", PUT THE FIREARM DOWN, DO NOT TOUCH, UNTIL GIVEN INSTRUCTIONS by the Range Officer
